Mr. Lo has extensive experience in the media industry. Before joining the Company, Mr. Lo worked for a number of major newspaper and television companies in Hong Kong. He is also a part-time member of the Central Policy Unit of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and a member and spokesman of the Newspapers Society of Hong Kong.

Mr. Morris Ho Kwok Fai is the chief executive officer of the magazine group of the Company and responsible for overseeing the publication of magazines which include "East Touch", "Teens", "PC Market" and "JET". Mr. Ho is a veteran in Hong Kong magazine industry and has extensive experience in the publishing industry. Prior to joining the Company, he was a director of Next Media Limited and the chief executive officer of the Apple Daily. He also held various management positions in a number of media and related companies.

The Board would like to welcome Mr. Tung Chee Chen, Mr. Lo Wing Hung and Mr. Morris Ho Kwok Fai to the Board and to take this opportunity to express its gratitude to Mr. Terrence Young and Miss Judy Inn for their valuable contributions during the past years.
